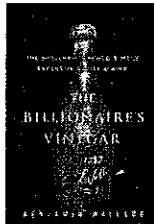

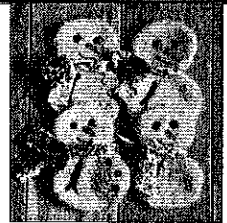

Iron Chef

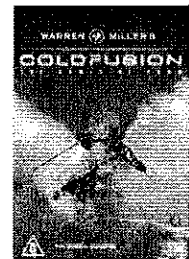
