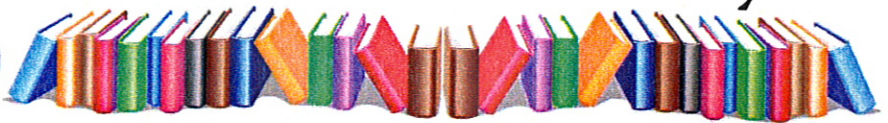

Monday, June 3rd at 6:00 p.m.

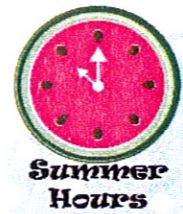


Storytime is every Wednesday at 10:30.


