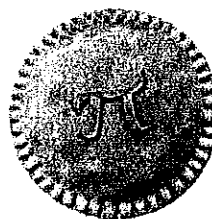

### Create your Skate

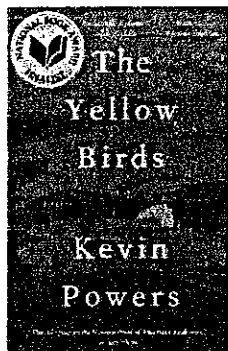

The session dates are **Monday, April 1st, Tuesday April 2nd, Friday April 5th or Sunday April 7th, all at 3 p.m.**

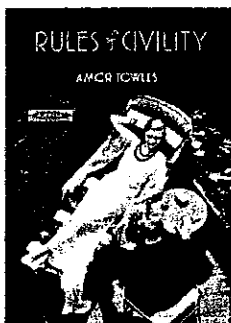

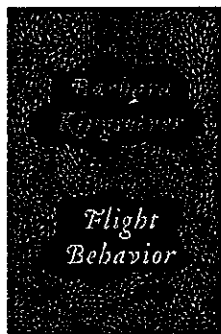

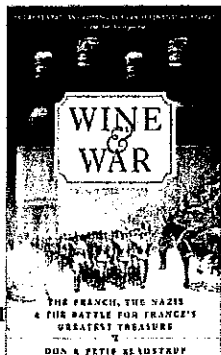
