

ALTAMONT FREE LIBRARY  
Accomplishments of 94/95

Maintained library hours at 40 hours per week.

Provided tours and introduction of library facilities to all Altamont Elementary first graders.

Developed and distributed a "Welcome to the Altamont Free Library" brochure to every village.

Increased Adult and Children Book Selections by 593 hardcover and 278 soft cover books.

Increased Reference and Children's Book Section using \$10000 from the Roger Keenholts Memorial Fund.

Increased Video/Audio Selection by 64 new items.

Filed and filled 453 book, 4 periodical, and 8 audio\visual tape requests for intra-library loans.

Presented 102 programs/activities presented in 1994 / 1995  
(3 programs for adults, 4 programs for young adults, 95 programs for children and families)

Completed 23115 transactions for the year (up from 21618 last year)

Had 20371 visitations for the year.

Provided a Summer Reading Program for 55 young readers.

Presented a Pre-School Story Hour Program twice a week.

Established an outreach service to Guilderland Center Nursing Home. Deliveries of large print books are made twice a month.

Participated in the Village Wide Garage Sale.

Fostered an increase in the number of active friends of the Library.

Showcased many area resident's interests and hobbies throughout the year in the library display case.

Created and prepared display at the Altamont Fair.

Participated in an adult literacy project funded by a state grant. Library has been provided a 486 IBM, with stack, and cd-rom. Several thousands of dollars of support software.

Presented Library information and needs to Board members of the Town of Knox and received \$1000.

Built Drop Box which will be installed in the Spring of 95.

Started a feasibility study on erecting of a new library building.

Applied for and received a \$1500 grant from UHLS for the feasibility study.
