The Summer Reading Program is a super fun series of free events and programs at the Altamont Free Library that celebrates reading, creativity and summer fun!

How the Summer Reading Program Works

Beginning on July 5th you can play weekly Summer Reading Program BINGO using BINGO cards that you can get at the library. Every week, mark your BINGO card for every time you spend 20 minutes of the day reading, or any of the other fun and creative activities you'll find each week on your BINGO card. For every line you get on your BINGO card (horizontally, vertically or diagonally) you'll get a raffle ticket. Those raffle tickets will be used to win awesome prizes at the end of the summer! The more lines you fill, the more tickets you earn, and the more chances you have to win a prize! If you need help doing any of the tasks in the BINGO card safely, don't forget to ask an adult you trust for help. If you need any help finding a great book to read, you can always ask a librarian!
